South Dakota has the latest draw applications deadline, June 25th to July 20th. If you have forgotten or missed the other western states application window, or applies and didn't draw, this is your last chance this year. Whitetail licenses are easy to draw but mule Deer are a little more difficult. Both Whitetail and Mule Deer can be drawn with 0 points. Points are only \$8 so it is the lowest point cost of any state.

Rifle White-tail Deer and Mule Deer

License Application Draw Information for South Dakota. South Dakota has a draw system of Big Game licenses like no one else, but it is a Mix of the way Nevada and Wyoming does their draws, with a South Dakota Twist. As a rule, in General it takes 0-1 point to draw a whitetail license and 2-3 points to draw a Mule Deer-Any Deer license. They also have the April Special Buck license application where you can move to the head of the class with a additional \$ 300 price added to your license to put you in a special draw. You can also just buy a point each year for only \$8. There are some pluses and minuses to this system and ways to beat the system. If you have any questions I recommend getting a point which is possible from April to August and to contact me for details.

South Dakota allots 70% of its licenses to residents and 30% toward Non-Residents in each draw. After each sequential draw the Non-Resident license pool is empty so the rebalance the drawing and put 30% of the leftovers in the resident pool into the Non-Resident pool.

The only draw that they don't do that is not that way is the increased price Special Buck License in April. This license draws from a larger pool and with 0-3 points you can get a Mule Deer or whitetail/Either Deer license that is good for the whole western half of South Dakota. Whitetail on the other had can be drawn through the regular draw with o or 1 point in most years. The hitch is that the draw is a Hybrid Random draw so you never know for certain if you will draw until you have license in hand.
