Hunt ID: CA-AL-WDeerMDeer-GRA5CHEANDEC-O7S-RIA6NB

Come hunt with the Canadian outfitter that hunts the province that has more record book whitetail hunt registered than any other province in Canada or State in the US. Come hunt with an outfitter that has a degree in what makes deer do what they do when they do it, and has a diploma to prove it from an accredited college. Is there anything else you need to increase your odds of taking home a record book buck besides a rope and a tree to tie the buck to? (We have lots of trees, but no ropes.)

Come hunt with an outfitter that hunts the beautiful foothills of the Rocky Mountains. This outfitter's area is in a secluded part of Alberta where thick bush and low hunting pressure result in trophy Deer that have never been hunted before. These big bodied, dark antlered deer truly die of old age. You will be hunting where two different habitats come together providing you the opportunity for Whitetail Deer and or Mule Deer depending on the season dates.

This outfitter spends the bulk of his year outfitting and guiding from the northern Yukon to the foothills of British Columbia. With such a diverse list of animals and habitats that he guides, there is no question he can find deer on his 1.2 million acres in Alberta. His educational background in

Ecosystem Management and Environmental Technologies provides him with a 3 dimensional knowledge of game animals and their habitat that you don't normally see in the outfitting and guiding industry. His constant drive to make every hunt enjoyable and successful along with his outgoing friendly attitude really sets the stage to make each adventure a personal experience for all clients.

November Canadian Temperatures are a great concern to me because I want my clients to be comfortable while they are hunting. We have a heated blind that you will look forward to getting into every morning.

Due to the low temperatures Alberta can experience in November, we use a special patented heated tower blinds that are tall enough to stand in and stretch, and have thick cloth walls that hold the heat in from your comfort. The zippered windows, comfortable 360 degree swivel seat and built-in shooting rail provide great visibility and a stable rest for shooting accurately. These tower blinds are fully portable and are constantly moved

to where deer movement is most productive. Hunters are always hunting the most productive areas.

Hunts mainly take place during the month of November when the rut is in full swing and big mature bucks become most vulnerable to being spotted by hunters. The exception is the early season Mule Deer and archery Whitetail hunts that begin in mid-October and end the 1st week in November.

The early season Mule Deer hunts take advantage of the bucks being in bachelor groups which makes them easier to scout and pattern. Later in the season, these bucks are hunted during the peak of the rut focusing efforts towards large open forestry cut blocks and cut-lines where big mature bucks are covering territory in search of receptive does. A combination of blinds and spot and stalk hunting methods are used to hunt these bucks. It depends on the location of big bucks that we are focused on and the habitat they are in. The best of both methods will be used to help you harvest your trophy.

Whitetail and Mule Deer can be hunted until the end of November. However, later season hunts seem to be more successful for Whitetail than Mule Deer. This is because of the Mule Deer migrating greater distances to find suitable wintering habitat and have a lower population. With Whitetails it is the exact opposite. The later season rut hunts are the most successful providing a 75% success rate and a great opportunity to harvest a Whitetail scoring 125-150 plus inches.

Mule Deer being less abundant and much wearier than Whitetails make them much more difficult to catch up to. Most hunters use them as second target on a combination hunt, unless they are a driven Mule Deer enthusiast. The average size of Mule Deer you can expect to harvest is also around the 150 inch mark.

You the hunter will fly into Grande Prairie on Saturday evening and get a hotel room for 1 night. I will pick you up Sunday and transport you from Grande Prairie to Grande Cache where you will stay in my house that has comfortable clean beds, hot shower and hot home cooked meals. Or there are plenty of motels in town along with restaurants.

You will hunt from fully enclosed heated tower blinds, ground blinds and tree stands from Monday to Saturday and then will be transported back to Grande Prairie Saturday evening. You will need to get a hotel room for Saturday night and then have your flights booked for Sunday. Flights typically leave around 6am and 9am. There are hotels and restaurants in Grande Cache where your guide will pick you up every morning before the days hunt and return you every evening.

Your meals and lodging are free with me for the hunt. You may also choose to stay in a hotel and eat at local restaurants. Hotels run about \$135 plus tax per night double occupancy.

Hunt Pricing

Whitetail Deer hunts and Mule Deer hunts are priced at \$4500 plus tax, These hunts are best scheduled from the last week of October till the end November.

Currently a discounted price of \$2795 plus tax, A combo, Whitetail Mule Deer hunt is \$5900 but currently a special combo hunt discount is available offering a Whitetail and Mule Deer combination hunt for \$3795 plus tax, plus \$500 for licencing and tag fees. If you don't shoot a second deer you will not have to pay the \$1000 trophy fee that is not added until your second deer is harvested. We feel if you don't fill we should reduce the price.

Licensing costs, plan on about \$ 500. This will cover your deer licensing and tag fees cover your wildlife certificate, hunting licence and tags for Whitetail Deer or Mule Deer, Wolf and Coyote.
