

**Discounted 5 DAY ALBERTA TROPHY HUNT FOR A RECORD CLASS WHITETAIL**



**ID Number: CA-WDeer-Rifle-Onoway-BBAAB-Terry-Guided**

**When you are done just shooting deer come to Alberta where the record books are filled!**

**Hunting Location: Onoway Canada/Big Bucks Alberta Outfitter**

**Length of Hunt: 5 days**

**This is a no draw license, outfitter has limited amount of vouchers.**

**Animals: Whitetail Deer-The hunt of a life time!**

**Level of Guiding: 2-1 guided**

**Food and Lodging are not included but you will be stay at the Starlight Motel and restaurant which works out quite since they open at 6am and you are picked up for hunt at 6:30 or 7, sunup is late this far north.**

**Food: Caboose Restaurants next to the Starlight Motel 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.**

**Animal size expected: 130 to 180**

**Opportunity/success: 99% opportunity 99% success**

**Season dates: November 1-31-10**

**Sell Price: \$4500 reduced to only \$3500**

**Booking: \$1000, , balance due 30 days before the hunt. The last two weeks of Nov. being the best rut hunting. The American week of Thanksgiving is the normal rut.(Don't say Canadian Thanksgiving it is in October.**

**Application Date Deadline: With guide contact early hunters must get a WIN card from Alberta Government. Then buy your license when you get to Edmonton or on the road to Onoway at a WalMart. You will need your WIN card to purchase.**

**Comments Fly into Edmonton, drive 1 hour to Onoway, Alberta, Canada, Starlight Motel**

**Guide will assist you in getting your license. After booking the hunt contact with guide to help get the Alberta WIN Card that you will need to get your license before the hunt. You will also need your passport. Numerous, record class bucks have come out of this hunt. There is a reason they call these big bucks Hawgs, when you see the huge size of their body and their antlers still look big. Hunting is in tree stands and ground blinds.**

**A few things to remember are that the Canadian Government is easy to work with fair and law abiding. If you do a few things you will save yourself a lot of problems.**

**Go into Canada with your WinCard, you can fly into Edmonton. You will also need a gun permit for your rifle, get it in the mail early. Have your passport up to date prior to entering Canada.**

**Your deer tag is for the antlers transporting back over the border. Leave the deer meat with the guide and bring back the antlers, cape, and most important your fill deer license. They don't tag the meat. Also carry ammunition separate from your rifle and not carry on. Ammo can't be running loose in your bag, X-Ray will see it. Carry ammo, even if it is reloaded in a cardboard manufactured box not a plastic box.**

**Alberta is all guided for Aliens, that's us Americans. A non-resident is a Canadian from another providence. You will see a low density of whitetails in comparison to many places farther south but the buck you see will be huge. This guide doesn't take anything less than 140.**

**Bring warm wicking, wind breaking clothing. You will probably be sitting in a treestand or ground blind. You want a propane heater (Buy bottles in Canada because of air transport regulations).**

**Also take plenty of hand and foot warmer pads. It can be as high as 60 or as low as -20F so bring some layer material. A flat shooting scoped rifle is best 30-06 minimum. You don't want to be tracking a wounded deer in this thick country and possible deer snow. These are big, big bodied deer and it take a lot to stop them. Shots are normally not long but they can be in CRP fields, power line right a ways, and alfalfa fields. Sight in dead on at 200 yards with a 30.06 180 and you should be fine.**

There are thousands of acres but your guide will put you at the best place in a ground or tree stand in the morning and evening. Back to town for lunch and then back out until dark.

Rent a car at the airport or pay extra to be picked up depending on if you come alone or with others.

Guide can have permission to hunt other farmers property but he can't pay them for access. This outfitter is a farmer so he is able to access a lot of other farmers property quite easily. You will be hunting 1 on 1 or 2 on 1 or 3 on one depending on the booking. It matters little because you will have a blind or treestand to yourself, and most cell phones work quite well.

The outfitter gets one Bull Moose voucher per year and they are in the same area as the deer. It can be a combo hunt for an additional \$4000 if the voucher isn't already spoken for.

Pay \$1000us down and the balance upon arrival. The best way to mail the deposit is to go to a bank and get \$1000 US in a check for Canadian currency at the exchange rate it is at that time.

You will be staying in the town of Onoway, Alberta, Canada. At the Local Motel, called Starlight Motel, and eating at its restraint and lounge. The town does have a grocery and some other shops and stores but any major shopping should be done closer to Edmonton.

Guided hunt discounted down to \$3,500 and it books up quickly.
