DISCOUNTED Do-It-Yourself Bear Hunt for Big Black Bears in Quebec Canada

\$2,500 hunt discounted \$850.00 to the rock bottom price of only \$1,650 (US)

Non-refundable deposit of \$1000 required when booking with the balance due 30 days before the hunt.

Length of Hunt: Five day baited hunt from tree stands in prime big bear country in Quebec. 200 to 400 pound boars have been taken here in the past. Use rifle, muzzle loader or archery equipment. Lodging is provided in rustic cabins, and the baits will be refilled by a guide prior to the hunt. You'll be in charge of your own baiting (baits are supplied). Many types of bait will be kept active and a guide will show you the bait locations when you arrive, and he'll give you a map that shows all of the available bait sites.

You can drive directly to the camp or fly to Montreal and drive to camp from there $(3\frac{1}{2}$ hours drive from airport).

The guide will meet you and make certain you are set up and recommend specific bait sites. You'll need to cook for yourself and bring your own dishes, pots and& pans and utensils.

This price is discounted in an effort to make bear hunting affordable and to allow hunters to harvest a good bear. This discounted price is only available if paid in cash in US dollars because of the fluctuations in the world money market. Also, you must book a group of two to four hunters. Only two groups at the time will be allowed to hunt with a maximum of 15 hunters for the entire season. This hunt takes place in the St-Maurice Wildlife Reserve territory which consists of 475 square miles and is located next to a 500 square mile federal park. Hunters will have exclusive hunting rights in this area. Stands, towers and blinds will be set up prior the hunt. Camps are accessible by trucks and use of ATV is possible to access bait sites (recommended is some area).

There is a full American plan available in a 1000 square mile exclusive area in a second Provincial Wildlife Reserve. The tags are available over the counter.

Level of Guiding: semi-guided and do-it-your-self hunting

Lodging: Cabins

Food: In town or do-it-yourself

Opportunity/success: Archery and muzzle loader tags are available over the counter. The rifle season is has a 75% draw success the first year with 99.9% draw success the second year.
