All photos on this web page were taken on trips in the last year or so. Our services are guided bow, rifle and muzzleloader hunts for: Elk, Deer, Bear, and Mountain Lion.

We operate in the Rio Grande National Forest under a permit issued by the USDA Forest Service.

We furnish a complete package hunt for a limited number of hunters who will receive a comfortable remote camp, gentle horses, experienced friendly guide service and above all plenty of good food.

Because of the different units we hunt and some need points or a landowner voucher to draw we are very familiar with the drawing and landowner voucher system.

For example in GMU0 76, we access the public ground via a private property which allows us prime hunting because the animal are not bothered by public land hunters. Then as the season gets underway we get inundated with animals being pushed to us by the public hunting pressure on the other end of the national forest.

We hunt GMU082, an over the counter elk unit in 2nd & 3rd season. We are nestled in the Sangre de Cristo's rough terrain, classified as a wilderness area. We furnish drop camp hunts which include tents, camp gear, cookware, and wood stoves. We pack you into camp along with your food and personal gear. We may make arrangements to check in with you during your hunt. Then we will pack you out along with your game.

We hunt private land in GMU085, an over the counter license elk unit with a limited number of landowner mule deer vouchers being available to us. Our Prices are for the blue collar work like ourselves and our hunts are very successful.

Mountain Lion

Lion hunting is so dependent on the weather and snow pack conditions that before booking I need to get dates and weather together. The highest success and lowest cost route is to be on an on-call list with a \$500 deposit. Anyone that isn't called before the end of the season gets a 100% refund if they wish or have the option to be first in line for the following December-April Season.

Limited License/Preference Points page.

Although the deadline is over, there is still a chance to obtain licenses. There are deer and elk licenses left over. See the **Leftover List**. You may also buy over the counter licenses.

Nonresidents apply at the same time and on the same application forms as resident hunters. They may purchase an over-the-counter license just the same as resident hunters.
