









Hunt ID: CO-ElkMDeerAntelope-KCL5AR-M3OB-IC7KR

This is one of the few areas that you can get a buck antelope, a buck deer and a cow elk with 0 points. Of course the bull elk licenses are easy to obtain also. We even have private property options with a "P" in the hunt code to offer.

Each hunter must provide their own gun and ammunition, license(s), and personal items. Blaze orange cap and vest are required by law for muzzle-load and rifle seasons. Hunters are responsible for the transportation and processing of all game. The weather conditions could vary from day to day. So come prepared for weather that could be warm to below freezing and from dry to wet conditions- so be prepared!

There is a lot of physical activity in the sport of hunting so keep this in mind as you prepare for your hunt. Also the elevation could be a factor for you. If you have any physical or health issues please let us know so we can help you enjoy your hunt.

Licenses (except special permits and muzzle-load) are available for sale over the counter, or by a draw system through the CP&W.

Licenses must be purchased before opening day of the season. You must have a Hunter's Safety Card if you were born after January 1, 1949.

We provide Guided Deer and Mule Deer Hunts on Private Land, located 16 miles Northwest of Steamboat Springs, Colorado in GMU214. We have 9,000 acres of prime hunting habitat for deer and Deer at elevations from 7,000 feet to 9,000 feet. There is a variety of hunting terrain, from open meadows to oak brush, aspen groves and dark timber. We have a very high success rate because with limit our number of hunters and manage the herds to provide quality animals for the taking.

We also provide facilities to hang and cool your game, and a place to process your own meat.

All hunts are guided with lodging and meals separate or not included.

50% of the hunting fee is required as a deposit to reserve hunt. Balance of the total fee is due in cash or money order upon arrival at camp. Deposit is non-refundable and a written contract is required; it will be provided when the hunt is booked.

All hunts are five consecutive days. If second season has more than four hunters one day will be added.

Hunters should plan to be in Steamboat Springs, Colorado the afternoon before the hunt begins.

2nd Season- Combined Deer & Elk October

3rd Season- Combined Deer & Elk November

4th Season- Either Sex Elk (Draw Only) November

Draw Only September

August-September

Only 4 Hunters

Fees for Skinning and Miscellaneous: \$50.00 for skinning.

Guided hunt fees:

Elk, Bull -----\$ 3,500

Cow -----\$ 995 either sex and cow licenses are available as a 2<sup>nd</sup> choice

Deer, Buck----- \$ 1995 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> season can be drawn with 0 points

Combination Bull & Buck----- \$ 4,495

Antelope, Buck----- \$ 1,195 Buck antelope can be drawn with 0 points

Each hunter must provide their own gun and ammunition, license(s), and personal items. Blaze orange cap and vest are required by law for muzzleloader and rifle seasons. Hunters are responsible for the transportation and processing of all game. The weather conditions could vary from day to day. So come prepared for weather that could be warm to below freezing and from dry to wet conditions- so be prepared!

There is a lot of physical activity in the sport of hunting so keep this in mind as you prepare for your hunt. Also the elevation could be a factor for you. If you have any physical or health issues please let us know so we can help you enjoy your hunt.

All hunts are five consecutive days. If second season has more than four hunters one day will be added. We only hunt the 1<sup>st</sup> and the second seasons along with Muzzleloader to allow the Deer to calm down and stay on the property all winter, then calf there in the spring. This assures us that the Deer will always be there when the hunting season comes.

Hunters should plan to be in Steamboat Springs, Colorado the afternoon before the hunt begins.

\*4th Season Starts on Wednesday

We have antelope hunts on private land which allows us to use "P" private land licenses in the draw so the number of points required is much lower than public land hunting.

Late Season Cow (Draw) December

In some cases there are license left over after the draw.
