Have you ever wanted to hunt Yellowstone National Park? You can't, so forget it. But you can hunt outside of the park boundaries. There are many herds that make up the huge wintering population in the Yellowstone area. They come from all directions, including north of Yellowstone. We hunt a 5 mile radius just 7 miles north of the park boundary, prime elk country. Success is high, prices are low and the meals are great for our local herds and migrating herds as they merge.

These bulls spend the summer with us and in addition you will see a lot of bull migrating through enroot to the park every fall. We hunt only the prime spots accessing by horseback, 4 wheel drive vehicle and foot. The typical 6x6 bull is somewhat common in our area. If you can shoot you can take home a bull.

This is not a rugged hunting camp but an enjoyable comfortable hunting lodge.

Awake to a early morning wake up to the smell of a hearty breakfast. Each morning something different is prepared but pancakes, bacon and eggs are always popular. Once the stomach is filled, you'll mount a gentle, sure footed horse, and head directly into the forest to hunt.

The fair chase hunt of the Majestic Mountain Monarch, the Elk, called "Wapiti" by natives, is one of the greatest trophies available to the North American Hunter. You will hunt the elk in their native habitat; this is not a migration hunt. The area has some heavily timbered, rugged terrain and you will hunt at over 8000 feet. This is not a private ranch harvest, you need to be in good enough physical condition to walk at least one mile and ride a horse at least two hours at a time. You will need to bring a 30-06 or better caliber rifle with which you are familiar. We have a good success ratio for hunters who come prepared to hunt.

Arrive home around dusk from a day of searching for, or tagging, the beautiful elk you've always dreamed about. Wash up and get comfortable, then come downstairs to one of Liz's delicious dinners. Each night a heartwarming, home cooked meal will be served. Steak, pasta, and other mouthwatering dishes will enhance your hunting experience with us. After dinner you can relax in the hot tub before getting a good night's rest. Our lodge will provide you a comfortable place to stay during your week hunt with us. Now you can enjoy an exciting day of hunting and come home to the best in lodging. Now isn't that what hunting is about, good hunting? Enjoy the comfort of a nice soft bed to sleep in, a warm shower available, wonderful food, a relaxing hot tub, and the chance to hunt trophy size elk in the beautiful Beartooth Mountains.

Elk Hunting Details

In this mountainous country, weather can range from balmy heat to freezing blizzards. It is usually temperate weather, but be prepared with layers of clothing, waterproof boots and outerwear.

There is one guide for every two hunters and a maximum of six hunters per week. Fishing in the area is excellent and the scenery alone is worth the trip.

Our designated hunting area, #316, opens the 15th of September for our early-bugling season and is an either sex area for elk.

If you're arriving by plane, you'll probably want to rent a car and drive over the beautiful Beartooth pass from Billings, MT or over Dead Indian Pass from Cody, WY. [Click Here](#) to see where we are located and how to get to our place.

- Taking the harvested game to a meat packer if you choose
