Take the Western 6 hunt course or fill your freezer with elk, the course is paid for all you pay for is the hunt and the lodging is free for the hunter. You can't get 30 years of experience in 1 day so we take 5 different hunts 1 per year to build your natural skills so that you have the skills and knowledge after you have completed this course. Add to this that the hunts are all discounted 20-40% to encourage new hunters into the sport. The course includes, Cow Elk, Doe Antelope, Buck Antelope, Mule Deer Doe, Mule Deer Buck, then Bull elk. All are free ranging hunts except for the cow elk in the beginning.

















Hunt ID: NM-CElkBElk-ATO7NR-R7Q-O5ND - High Fence & Free Ranging Hunts  $1^{st}$  step isn't the 5 season hunting learning course begins here. It can also be a great hunt for a new hunter, or a husband and wife team to put meat in the freezer and have a great hunt in nice surroundings. Meat processing is only 30 miles away so it can be cut, wrapped and frozen for your trip home.

This outfitter has everything from high fence bull and cow elk, to trophy free ranging trophy mule Deer at 170-200 inch class. The ranch is 27,000 acres, with 2000 acres of it under high fence. The high fenced in area is rugged but hunting can be by walking or by spot and stalk with a 4 wheel drive vehicle. All free ranging Buck deer hunt and high fence Bull elk hunts have 5 day lodging and meals included with the hunt.



Cow Elk Meat Hunt in High fence- 2000 Acres over THREE 1 square mile areas surrounded by 8 miles of fence, once you are in you and the elk never see the fence.

Take your youth hunter on his first elk hunt with a positive outcome. Free ranging elk hunts are great but for a youth days in the cold walking through deep snow, cold sleeping in the tent with 10 degree nights, and not ever getting a shot is not a good way to get a youth to enjoy his first elk hunt. Most can completely loose interest in hunting activities and that is not what you want for your hunting companion. Each phase has pre-requisites required to be met before the hunt on live animals. The goal of the program is to build your skills to make successful hunts, and to always take home a animal from your hunts. The pre-requites required are done before you go to the hunt as in this one shooting skill requires 3 shots in the black of a target with a .270 or larger rifle.

This hunt is the 1<sup>st</sup> Phase of the successful Hunting education and Harvest program. It is designed for the new hunter, youth, adult, wife, handicapped or a great cow elk eating meat hunt. The goal is to use this as a beginning hunt by beginning with the hunter skill building and coming home successful with a cow elk to prove it. This type of learning is not offered, available, nor can be matched by a free ranging elk hunt because of the lack of control of the free ranging animals.

## **Pre-Requisites are:**

You must pass a Hunter Safety class and graduate with a hunter safety number from any state. You must show you are safe with the firearm in handling, loading and unloading it. You must be a NRA member, (A \$25 cost which also provides you a magazine subscription.) A rifle .270 caliber or larger with a scope that you can hit the 7"circle on a target at 100 yards 3 times. You will have a rest to shoot on, and the outfitter can assist you with shooting pointers. Then if passing the above you will go with the outfitter to hunt elk, he will show you what to look for on the ground, the tree trunks and through binoculars to locate the elk. The outfitter will go into details why elk do what they do and why you find them in certain terrain and not in other. This will be followed by a stalk that may become a hands and knees crawl to get close enough for a good shot at the elk.

Once you have shot the elk he will show you how to clean the elk to preserve it for the good eating that it is. He will assist you in getting the elk to a local processor to have cut, wrapped and frozen to take home with you unless you want to have it butchered locally where you live.

The following requirements are similar with more difficult hunting and more difficult shooting. We recommend that you spend as much time as possible at your local rifle range to build your shooting skills. The more you can research the animal that you will be hunting the better. Remember this is not a class just to shoot an animal; it is a class to build hunting skills to make you a successful hunter and in each class take home an animal.

You are able to take non-hunting guests on this hunt for \$ 75 to cover meals and the lodging so you can all be together on the hunt.

The 2nd phase of this learning to be done the following year is to hunt free ranging doe antelope guided in Colorado or Wyoming.

The 3rd phase is a buck antelope in Wyoming or Colorado.

The 4<sup>th</sup> phase is a Mule Deer Doe

The 5<sup>th</sup> Phase is a Mule deer buck.

The 6th is free ranging Cow Elk

The 7th and final is a Bull Elk

You will be asked to shoot at least 3 shots at a target 100 yards away to show your awareness of firearm safety with your rifle and prove your shooting skill level is adequate to take a cow elk. The enclosure is quite large so the hunter will need to dress for a hunt. The \$450 cow elk license is not required for the cow elk hunt.

The guide will instruct the hunter in the field as to which elk to shoot and getting a solid rest to shoot from. A bi-pod or shooting sticks are recommended. Drawn blood is considered a kill and the guide will do everything possible to get the hunter on any elk that the hunter wounds but does not drops.

This is good incentive to not only shoot well but learn to shoot well before arriving for the hunt. Safety is of the upmost important but to enjoy the sport you must a level of rifle accuracy, this is to build that level.

## **Trophy Free Ranging Mule Deer Hunt**

These big bucks are highly managed with only a few taken in September Muzzleloader r the early October Rifle Season. These mule deer are highly managed and only a few taken each year. It is a free ranging deer hunt on 25,000 acres. This is a summering area for these big bucks so the archer, muzzleloader and first rifle are the best seasons to hunt before the snow fall begins that quickly send the big bucks packing. The area genes are good along with the natural feed. Bucks range 170 to over 200 inches gross Boone and Crocket scoring.

# **Trophy Bull Elk Hunt in High fence- 2000 Acres**

It is rugged country, possibly the most rugged in the area. The bulls can be very people shy because they are self-sustaining year around. The rugged country isn't too difficult for the elk to travel through and they know where to go to get lost. Hunting can be completely walking or it can be travel via a 4x4 drive truck, then glass from the high spots. Once the bull of your choice is finally spotted it is difficult stalks where you can get close enough for a good shot. Meat processors are about 3 miles from the ranch also Taxidermists. The \$650 new Mexico elk license is not required for the high fence elk hunts.

In addition shooting one here in September and then 1 in New Mexico, then 2 in Colorado is completely legal.

The hunt comes with one night of meals and lodging for the hunter. For a non-shooting guest meals and lodging is \$ 75.

This hunt outside of beautiful Chama New Mexico is a hunt that will start your youth off right with gun safety, a shooting skill required and an elk to take home to show for it.

We are only going to offer 4 of these hunts per year so get your deposit in soon as possible. Hunting dates begin in September and go through January.

This \$2000 hunt but \$605 is picked up through the plan to build new hunters in the future making the hunt only \$1495 for this special hunts following these hunt criteria.
