We can always use some more ttricks in our bag of tricks when we are talking elk hunting, they are always learn so you need to keep learning to become successful. You will learn the tricks then put them to use on this hunt daily.

This hunt is \$3500 reduced down to only \$ 2195 for a 1 on 1. If you bring a buddy hunter you can book as two hunters or more at a time and the price can be reduced down to only \$ 1595. Also if your freezer is real empty you can take a second cow at only \$ 795 more.

These licenses sell out early so get it booked as soon as possible before the licenses are sold out.

For the DIY Hunter that wants to be good at what he does this provides him with tips and tricks that he was not aware of and can quickly put to use on elk, without it he is costing him a elk oportunity because of his lack of all of the trios every year tips and trick of elk or mule deer. This the only class that you get to take home knowledge, skill and your class project! Some try to make all of the mistakes theirselves, but life is to short to learn everything by making all of the

mistakes yourself. Here you can get the equivalent of you 30 years of hunting experience all molded down into 3 days.

All you need is a Cow Elk License for unit **49 Type 6** which is usually leftover for a short time and you are coming home with a cow elk and great elk hunting memories on this private ranch!

This is a 3-day elk 101 learning experience that you will remember for the rest of your life! This cow elk hunt is a great elk hunting learning experience. As you are hunting he will point out and show things that will make you an experience Elk hunter and carry the knowledge to hunt elk anywhere. You will even use those tactics to take home a cow elk if you listen and learn well. Many of these skills and much of this knowledge is only gained by the school of hard knocks and lost elk experiences. It is all about learning from others mistakes so you don't have to make them yourself. We address these high demand topics that with high detailed information and practical experience. Learn to be an elk hunting expert. Many have hunted elk but put them in a pristine environment and it is basically start from scratch to learn the elk patterns and traits in a new area.

This hunt is for knowledge and for taking home a cow Elk at the same time while using the skills that you learned.

This is also 3-day cow Elk hunts in Wyoming to fill the freezer with the Wyoming Cow hunt license the lowest in the US states only \$ 288 instead of over \$ 640 like the bull elk license.

Habitat: Private Ranches and adjacent property's

These are a great way to fill the freezer and have a good time doing it. Cow licenses are available after the draw for a brief time. Even if you are not hunting right away, book so I can get you a license before they are sold out. These hunts are no preference point draws hunts as long as you have your application in the Wyoming Game and Fish before the May 31 deadline, which is long after these hunts will be booked. The units hunted are <u>Unit 49 with a License for unit 49-6 you will take home a cow elk.</u> Sometimes there are some leftover licenses available for the leftover licenses sale on July 19th each year but nothing to depend on. He hunts either private or public land where ever the Elk are located. An Elk ranch is usually his main destination. You will be hunting mostly private ranch land for the cows, depending on the days you select you may never see another hunter except in town. In the hunt this hunt has been running almost 100%, but I just list it as High Success Rate. This hunt is not an extremely physical hunt, no horses, the most part no walking, riding in a truck with a good heater. This can be very importation in December. The worse the weather the better the hunting.

As a rule, when shooting cows, they are in small or even large herds so you are able to get two out of the same herd depending on your sneaking and shooting skills. If not, you will fill one license than go after a second. The landowner charges the outfitter \$ 695 which is customary on private land cow hunts.

Meals are not included but 2 local restaurants will be where you eat and each time you will take the occasion to go over 2 of the educational list items and share experiences. Lodging is local running about \$50-\$70 but can be more per night depending on the dates. The area is a very popular deer and elk hunting area because of its population.

If you like hunting deer this outfitter is your blessing, as long as he has slots available, because he has multipole good deer hunting locations for Mule Deer, Elk and even Whitetail with guided hunts to die for, at prices he has discounted. A private land guided deer hunts starting at only \$ 1795 is a steal on private land and guided. Guided 5-day whitetail Hunts all of November through the rut for only \$2495, then Deer at only. Then when we ask the trophy Mule deer hunters what they want he even has that at only \$ 500 or equal vent to just \$100 per day. In addition, any hunter if the guides area available can hunt 1 on 1 with an experienced guide for only \$500 which again has the 1 on 1 fee reduced from \$ 1000 per hunt to only \$500.

Wyoming Hunting is all about getting licenses when they are available. Many wait, and the licenses sell out before they put in for one. This outfitter has a **Bull Elk** and **Economy Cow hunt** plus 2 **Economy levels (3 day & 5 Day) of Mule Deer Hunts,** then **for the Trophy Hunter a**

physical Trophy Mule Deer Hunts in a Badland hunt hitting honey hole pockets from an ATV with 15 minutes to 1 hour walks back in at other places few people ever see.

Mild Winters in these areas have increased Game numbers but the Wyoming Game and Fish has not increase the number of license given out each year. This has made hunting success go through the roof, which is great.

With because Wyoming Game and Fish has hunter's requests and moved the license application deadlines from March 15th to May 30th the number of applicants have increased by 20% which is higher than any other state. License that were leftover in the past are now drawn out or even need a point to draw the license.

To help with the massive numbers of hunters for leftovers they have had to add a second draw to their process so they could handle the large number of applicants. This has made the "Leftovers" dwindle down severely, and this is the 3rd year of this process.

The best way to get in is apply in May before May 31 for the Deer or Antelope. The Cow elk are available early so get them as soon as possible with a drawing deadline for elk cows the last week of June. This "Leftover Draw" does not use preference points like the prior draw, it is a random draw.

After that it is all first come first serve leftovers. Bottom line this may sound a bit complex so the safest way is if you want to hunt get a license as soon as possible because for the most part they do sell out long before the beginning of the season.

Keep in mind this is only the non-resident licensing system, residents have their own dates to deal with.

This outfitter books lightly to continue to have an excellent quality hunt. He has gone from 3-day hunt to 5-day hunts because the weather is so important in hunting these big Wyoming bucks that if the weather is against you it may take 2-3 to get the weather working with you.

These deer did not get big by being dumb. Be certain you can shoot well so when the opportunity presents yourself you are ready and have adequate shooting skills. TO IMPROVE YOUR MULE DEER HUNTING SKILLS INCLDING shooting without sitting in a shooting bench are the higher your odds for success and animal size. It is still not a guarantee when you are hunting free ranging animals but like going to Las Vegas you want to put as many things on your side to improve your odds.

MULE DEER

This outfitter ran 100% last year and that's his target for this year. All Mule Deer Hunts are the western Classic mode of operation, spot and stalk.

Taking only a limited number of (total of 6) Deer hunters per season but requiring them to be booking 2 together he has been able to make this hunt extremely affordable. The land varies from open and rolling alfalfa fields to junipers and cactus. Some is feeding areas, and some is bedding area.

A good trick that these bucks play is to go on the opposite side of the fence when you come into the area. This outfitter can take you on both sides of the fence which puts these bucks in the truck. They big bucks have been around a long time so when you get after them this isn't their first rodeo. They know enough to ditch every nimrod that has pursued them in the past. This outfitter is a Wyoming native and hunting all of his live knows tricks that these big bucks have never seen before. You will learn more about hunting big bucks from this outfitter in one hunt than you could learn in a lifetime of hunting Wyoming Muley's.

Below you will see he has provided a few discounted hunts this year because of some new property but they will go fast. He is 90% now and they will fill completely in the following weeks.

Private or Public Land. In these hunts the outfitter is licensed so he can outfit and Guide in the public land, BLM or National Forest, State or other, but his main hunting is done on private land.

The ability to legally hunt public land allows him to cross over a fence from private to public to get to certain areas that others are blocked out of because he has leased the private property adjacent to the public property which has very difficult access from the private side which provides a safe area for the bucks to move into and stay out of the public land hunting pressure.

The bottom line is this he has the tool, knowledge, and rights to go where the deer are and that is what you are after anyway.

The **Region R** Hunts are very limited in availability and in license availability but has a 15% chance of drawing with 0 points, and a 100% chance of drawing with 1 point. We let the drawing success decide who hunts and who waits a year and goes. Although this means you may or may not draw with 0 point you are assured to draw with 1-point Trophy Hunter are accustom to needing 3,4,5,6 or more points for a quality area. In the big picture this is a sleeper are that many hunters have don't know about to be able to get this quality with a 0-1point requirement is very unusual. During the summer I always send out information requesting hunters to get points in multiple areas so that they have the points in their account when the May 31st draw comes around.

In Wyoming they are different from any other state. You can get a point for \$40 at draw time, or out of the blue from July 1-September 31. This is felt to be "Off Season" and the farthest from anyone's mind that time of the year. We even apply for them for our hunters that book the hunt, so there is no effort on the hunter's part.

At the May 31st draw date, you can also put in for a point but in both cases the point cannot be used during that year. Add the extremely unique part about Wyoming is the only state that I know of that if you apply for an area that requires a point to draw, and you have 2 points they will refund the extra point to you in a check. Why Not Build Points? You heard me right, **unbelievable,** the best customer service program that I have ever seen from a state for hunters, the others just sit back and keep all the cash.

So, what is the catch? The preference points only application period for two (2) consecutive years, all accumulated points for that species will be lost. That is another reason this hunt is such a value, you only need 1 point instead of 6, 7 or more which exposes you to this technicality.

The only thing that you can do if you don't think ahead and get the \$40 point is to use the "Special Buck Program" which a few other states like South Dakota which also requires you to put in 2 months early to use the program, where Wyoming does not. The Special Program is to put in for a license that is \$389 and pay an additional \$288 for a total of \$677.

Now both areas have a 100% draw rate with 1 or more Wyoming point. If you don't have any Wyoming preference points don't sing the blues. Wyoming has a Special Buck pool that you can get into by paying \$ 677 instead of the \$389 for your license. In this pool you will be a 100% draw.

I wrote this twice to remind everyone if you don't want a license then to get a \$40 point in the bank.

Season dates for X

For this region you will be hunting in unit 124 or 122 depending on where the deer are. This is a small badlands area with private land to hunt. It draws 100% so it is a slam dunk for a deer license at this time. The outfitter only takes 2-4 hunters per year in this open area.

(Note: In Wyoming the state is broken down into Units. Non-Resident licenses are good for Regions, which contain multiple units. Another licenses drawing fact is Wyoming has landowner

vouchers, but you seldom hear about them. The reason is the farmer/Rancher/Landowner can only get them for his direct family, so he has no way to sell them to the general public like in other states. So simply put unless you want to marry the Farmers Daughter, the program doesn't work for you.)

Region M is much easier to draw with 0 points than Region R, so since you have 2 choices to select in and if you select Region R as your Primary then you can select Region M as your second choice and in the special buck still draw it.

The State does a survey then labels some of the surveys valid and some not valid. These 2 units are at 54% to put that in perspective the highest success rate in the state is this 5th Highest success regions in the state. As it is we always run 100% on our guided hunts, what drops the others so low is lack of access to private land and our outfitters and guides knowledge of deer and the country they live in. This shows that getting a deer is not a slam dunk in these areas but with our guided hunts if you can shoot well you will end up with horns on your wall from the hunt.

The Region R Hunts are very limited in availability and in license availability but has a 3% chance of drawing with 0 points, and a 100% chance of drawing with 1 point. We let the drawing success decide who hunts and who waits a year and goes. Region M on the other hand draws 88% with 0 points and 100% with 1 point.

This outfitter has found that different hunters what different types of hunts, sizes and prices. Because of this and because he has many, many different Deer hunts to offer we have broken them down into A-E to make it simpler. Most hunter have their hunt request order of importance is these order

Type of Deer: Mule Deer, Whitetail Deer, or Either

Hunt Price: Backed \$1500, \$2000, \$3000, \$4000, More

Season Dates: October 1-15 or 15-31

(This can be to match an Antelope hunting the same dates/area.)

Meals or lodging options: Lodge, Motel, whichever is lower in cost and a better option. (In these hunts we remove the lodging and meals from the hunt before even endorsing them because you are more content with the price and service levels you select.

<u>5 DAY TROPHY RUT HUNTS \$ 4500 DISCOUNTED DOWN TO ONLY \$ 2995. (Just</u> \$ 1500 Deposit) UPGRADE TO 1 ON 1 AT AN ADDITIONAL \$1000.

This **Region M Hunt** is a physical hunt you will be hunting what is called, "The Badlands." The is very little vehicle access and the Mule Deer know it. The stay here and grow old, their antlers show it. October 1-10

Being during the rut also helps make these bucks more accessible by foot and easier to locate because of their searching for does. They are much easier to spot during this time because if you see a herd of does there will usually be a big buck either with them or close by. In addition, the brisker weather forces everything to eat more and bed lest, which is to your advantage. This can

be a physical hunt but well worth it. The hunter passed on a 180 buck because he saw so many good bucks he felt he could get closer to 190.

HUNT B

5 DAY HUNT \$ 4900 DISCOUNTED DOWN TO ONLY \$2795. (Just \$ 1400 Deposit)

Quality Mule Deer Hunts: Season dates 10/15-10/24 5 groups of 2 **Region R**.

Upgrade to 1 on 1 \$1000

This is a 5-day hunt in Region R guided 2 on 1 hunt you may shoot any deer you see most take 4x4 5x5 or 6x6 depending on the weather, and their shooting ability.

On the 5 day it is close to 100% because of the weather window and the shooting is important but it is also possible to have more deer shot opportunities due to the above detail.

HUNT C

3 DAY HUNT \$ 2900 DISCOUNTED DOWN TO ONLY \$1995. (Just \$ 995 Deposit)

Management Mule Deer Buck Hunt: Season Dates are 10/15-10/31 3 groups of 2 here **Region M**. Upgrade to 1 on 1 \$500

Keep in mind on a Guided 2 on 1 these days hunt it is very possible to not have any weather change. A weather change, snow, warming trend and such is what makes deer move to adjust to the change. This is what makes deer visible everywhere you look. Without it they can go where it gives them the best odds not you but will move to that location which makes the visible during movement. They do day bed close to their food source and be more alert than they are when weathering a storm. The success rate on a 3 day is about 60% depending on the weather and the shooting skills. This hunt takes place in **Region M**. The hunt includes 2x2,2x3,3x3,3x4 Mule Deer, along with a whitetail that is a 4x4 Hybrid cross whitetail/Mule deer. They are nice deer, big deer but a strain that we want to delete.

HUNT D

5 DAY HUNT \$ 3900 DISCOUNTED DOWN TO ONLY \$2995. (Just \$ 1500 Deposit)

Limited quota is drawn by the Unit requiring 3-5 points tom draw with big deer Hunting Unit 125 **Trophy Hunt** instead of a region, it has badlands area a more but always hunted 1 on 1 because it low density high quality Mule Deer. Known as

the ultimate for Mule Deer wall hangers and is a physical hunt you will be hitting the hot spot pockets that traditionally have the hat racks day bedding in this area. Located NW of Worland, Wyoming.

HUNT E

5 DAY HUNT \$ 3400 DISCOUNTED DOWN TO ONLY \$2495. (Just \$ 1200 Deposit)

This hunt is for the Whitetail Deer hunter or the one who has never shot a big whitetail. It is easy to draw with 0 points which is unusual in Wyoming. It is mostly river bottoms and agricultural fields. The hunt is Unit 41 Type 3 but is a RUT Hunt all of November when the big bucks get dumb.

Habitat: Multiple types of habitat that is where these big bulls stay where the deep draws and cliffs make it difficult to hunt so few hunters ever go there.

There is no trophy fee on these, but if you do see a 4x4 or larger Mule Deer then there is a \$1000 trophy fee on that deer because we want those to be our breeders for the future. This is a 3-day Mule Deer 101 in **Region M** from above learning experience that you will remember for the rest of your life! This Mule Deer hunt is a great Mule Deer hunting learning experience. As you are hunting he will point out and show things that will make you an experience Mule Deer hunter and carry the knowledge to hunt Mule Deer anywhere. You will even use those tactics to take home a buck Mule Deer if you listen and learn well. TROPHY BULL ELK HUNT

7 days Bull Elk Hunt in Wyoming Trophy area is \$10,000 discounted down to only \$7,195 For a 1 on 1 hunt add \$ 1000 to the price of the hunt.

The bull elk application deadline is EARLY. The Deadline for Bull Elk applications in Wyoming is January 31st the earliest of any deadline date anywhere that I am aware of. Because of this we place a priority on getting applications in for bull elk early. The can go in anytime between December 1, to January 31, a 60-day window.

Trophy Hunt hunting bulls over 300 inches. We have had high success in this area and taken 340, and 360's. The catch is some areas require more points than to draw a bull elk license. The higher the points to draw the bigger the bulls in the area is a good rule to look at. Depending on your preference points we will get you in elk. This is a pack in hunt and as said above the area is defined by your preference points and the ability to draw the license. We will pack into the area and get back behind the areas where other hunters go. Our history has proven to have us come out with some of the largest bulls in the unit that you draw. We have a number of units that we are permitted to outfit/guide in.

Guided Merriam Turkey. These turkeys are old with long beards and big spurs. They have had almost no hunting pressure. **2 Day Guided hunts**, \$ 700 reduced down to only \$ 345.

There is also fall turkey hunting which can be rifle, shotgun or archery if time is available.

Limited to only 2 hunters per year.
