DON'T MISS THIS SPECIAL IN THE LAND OF NOT ONLY WHITETAIL AND TURKEY BUT ALSO BEAR, YES BEAR. There are a total of 4 bear tags available per year so when they are gone they are gone. They are done on a cap system ties to the number of bears shot when reporting you shot a bear it is added to the game and fish total. Once that match has been made the bear season is over. So that is when we go back to deer hunting. Most of the bear hunting is tree stand like deer but with bear bait instead of a protein feeder. Bear hunt are \$4500 but we have 3 slots discounted down to only \$3195, and hunt deer at the same time before and after bear for only \$1495, a second deer is only \$995. These are some of the biggest deer in the state due to the genes and the feed.

This hunting is in the timberland of the Ozarks. Wild game is fed protein; deer, bears and turkey you name it these feeders are the honey hole in the wooly Jurassic Park!

Don't miss the Spring Turkey season in the Ozarks one of the things the Ozarks are famous for is their out of this world turkey population and multi bird limits. Before the season it is not unusual to see flocks of 10-20 Toms together, but when the strut kicks in there toms and hens everywhere. This property is over loaded with its share of big Toms. Because of this the landowner has cut the turkey prices in ½ until he gets down to a reasonable number of turkeys on the property. A Spring DIY Turkey \$ 350 reduced down to only \$225 no meals or lodging 3 day hunt. Guiding add \$ 200 per day reduced down to only \$100 per day. A second bird \$ 200 reduced down to only \$ 100.

HUNT ARKANSAS WHITETAIL DEER IN JANUARY WHEN THE ARCHERY SEASONS IS CLOSED ACROSS THE US !!!!

This Yellville, Arkansas Outfitter has allowed the archery price to be discounted \$500 for January and allowed you to shoot a buck or a doe whitetail.

This property has been managed to produce some of the largest bucks in Arkansas. Trail cams, tree stands, climbing tree stands, feeders, ponds, streams, heavy wood loots and many, many food plots have made these properties not just bedding area but feeding areas inside bedding areas to assist the big nocturnal buck in coming out in the small openings during the daylight hours. This also increases day light travel on the travel corridors and exposed to the awaiting archer, muzzleloader and rifle shooters.

The closest town for lodging is Yellville, Arkansas, about 200 miles from the Texas border. It is legal to bait deer in Arkansas.

Bear zone 2 (our zone) has NO zone quota for the 2015 season. Baiting deer/bear IS allowed on private land.

Shooting Hours: 30 Minutes Before Sunrise Until 30 Minutes After Sunset

Four day hunts on these 4 different deer prime properties are geared to use the property that matches the weapon. The more open property areas are geared toward rifle shooters while the thicker undercover and brush is geared toward the archer or muzzleloader shooter.

After making a deposit for the hunt you will revive full hunting locations details and the outfitter name, phone and email address. I will be receiving your information at the same time. Feel free to call me if I don' call you first.

Offering Deer Hunts, come experience the January rut when the northern whitetail have long since passed the rut and the temperatures hug the zero mark. We have 70 warm degree highs and 35-40 degree lows during the winter, enjoy it and enjoy hunting the rut.

The area has a first rut during the 2nd-4 week of November. The second rut is for the fawns that were born in May are ready to breed and produce their 1st fawn on their birthday, and the does that were missed in November. Either way it is non-stop action from the second week in November through the end of December.

For January and February the bucks group up into bachelor herds but for the most part are in recovery mode for the weight and energy they had expelled for the previous 2 months during the rut.

At this point they are very easily to pattern / they don't burn an ounce of energy that they don't need to use. They get lazy and drop their normal defense routines. When you see a big buck moving watch him well it is not unlikely that there is another buck behind him, possibly even bigger!

Your guide has pre-scouted the area and knows the deer activity and has put you in the best place for success. Exchanged cell phone numbers and use it to text or call your guide before leaving your stand. These big bucks are smart and are very oriented to scent. If you are told to stay in the stand until your guide returns do so. Wandering through the area will bump the bucks throughout the area. If you shoot something call your guide for assistance before leaving your stand. This is all for your hunting success and safety.

This is also a factor in gutting your deer. Please confirm if you do clean your deer ask you guide first we want to do everything possible to keep the area as undisturbed as possible and also keep coyotes and other predators and scavengers. The lack of them helps keep our fawn and turkey mortality low and increase hunting opportunity and your hunting success.

Rates - All of the following prices do not include meals and lodging. All prices & dates subject to change.

4 day Archery hunting \$1995 reduced down to only \$ 1395. Extra days are \$100

4 day Muzzleloader hunting \$2095 reduced down to only \$ 1495. Extra days are \$100

4 day Rifle hunting \$2195 reduced down to only \$ 1495. Extra days are \$100

Extra Doe after primary deer- \$150

A second Buck with any weapon is discounted down to only \$ 995

Bear hunting is done free ranging and over bait with a high population of large bears. A combo hunt could hunt deer in the mornings and bear in the afternoon and evenings.

Non-Hunting guest \$ 100 per day if able to sit in stand with you if approved by your guide.

Regulations:

Arkansas allows Scoped Muzzleloaders

All deer licenses are available over the counter at Walmart and sporting goods outlets.

License cost is \$25 for residents and \$150 for non-residents for 5 days of hunting and has tags for 2 bucks and 4 does.

Any one born after January 1st 1968 is required to have a Hunter Safety card to buy a license.

People 16 and older must have a valid license to hunt or fish in Arkansas.

All Gun Deer hunters must wear at least 400 square inches of hunter orange or chartreuse above their waist and a hunter orange or chartreuse hat during modern gun or muzzleloader seasons for deer, elk and bear. Blaze orange camouflage is legal. Exceptions to this rule are:

Note: Hunters must still wear their hunter orange when they are in their deer stand.

Portable, pop-up ground blinds used on public land during firearms deer, bear or elk seasons on public land must have at least 144 square inches of hunter orange or chartreuse on each visible side of the blind at least 3 feet above the ground.
