### **THIS IS A TRUE, PROFESSIONALLY GUIDED HUNT**

Our guides are constantly scouting looking for new setups, baiting and resetting stands, always looking for something new and hot to put you on.

Our areas are becoming over populated with deer, turkey and other animals, which makes for great hunting for the outdoorsmen. Whether you are a first time hunter or an experienced hunter, we have the best Ontario hunting vacations in Canada and we cater to every hunter's needs and abilities.

We have an average as high as 80% kill and as low as 40% depending on the quality of hunters and their goals, the weather, moon phases and plain old luck (lots of our repeat customers are passing on bucks most hunters would kill (we could have 90%-100% kill if we did not impose minimum to insure quality hunts).

Our deer hunts are scheduled around the peak of the rut in our area to give you the highest percentage chances. We have given our hunters outstanding opportunities at trophy deer but feel with the past 3 mild winters, predictions of the same for this year, and large numbers of medium sized bucks sighted and coming up because of it besides the 3 1/2- 6 1/2 year old trophies already present, the best is yet to come in the next few years.

### **WHERE YOU WILL BE HUNTING**

We have experienced and passionate hunting guides who will take you through scouted land to where the most game is. We hunt a 35 mile area where the big bush country yields to farmlands and timber cuts providing huge expanses of country to hunt in. This is an area well known for its big whitetails by the locals and only just opened to nonresident hunters in recent years.

Our Ontario guided hunting vacations take place in our approximately 8000 acres plus private land along with approximately 25,000 acres of remote government land. We hope to hunt over hundreds of thousands more that are available that we are currently scouting.

While some stands will be overlooking fields or cuts and could require long range shooting most stands are situated in the bush with shots average 40-100 yards to maximize contact during the bucks daytime movements. Lots of our bucks are shot from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

## **HOW YOU WILL BE HUNTING**

This not a canned, fenced or guaranteed hunt. You will earn your trophy and we expect you to hunt as hard and diligently as we work to put you on them. We like to book true hunters who realize that they are here for a trophy but also measure the quality and experience of a hunt by more than just the kill. Come with this attitude and you will not be disappointed.

For each hunting trip you will be provided with 1 or 2 guides and you'll be given the best information on how we do our hunting and the most effective way to hunt the game. We don't want you to waste any time with us so we make sure each of our hunters are fully prepared for the hunt ahead. Our guided hunting trips cannot be compared to any other hunting experience you've ever had, we are truly one of a kind.

Hunting strategy is discussed and stands picked according to wind, weather and recent sign for the hunt. Some stands you are taken to by ATV, some by 4WD truck then ATV, some 4WD truck and or ATV then a short walk and some require a long walk in after a drive. Your capabilities and wishes will be discussed beforehand. We hunt from dawn till dark out of ground blinds, 12-16 foot ladder stands and some portable lock-in stands situated along key runways, scrapes, travel corridors and feeding areas.

We also have portable blinds that can cover stands and can be heated if the weather gets to cold. Most stands will also be baited to keep does in the area, this keeps the bucks competitive, coming in from other areas constantly checking for does in estrus and very receptive to calls and rattling.

Your guide will check on you at noon by radio, if you shot or killed a buck he will track and or retrieve your game and transport you to camp for congratulations, field dressing, pictures and care of your game. If not he will be scouting, setting and baiting stands (as he did in the a.m.) till he comes to check on you and pick you up at dark to take you back to the lodge for a another great meal (you will not go home having lost weight) and a recap of the days hunt. After that it's back to your room complete with twin beds, hot showers, phone and color TV for a good night's sleep cause 4:00 a.m. will come again soon enough.

## **ITEMS TO BRING**

License or hunters safety card proving past hunting experience we can keep or photocopy or license cannot be issued. No exceptions, it is the law - IMPORTANT! Also if you have a felony of any kind on your record you won't be allowed into Canada.

WARM CLOTHING, HAT AND BOOTS, layered clothing and felt lined boots are essential. Do not under estimate needs; you will be on stand from daylight till dark with average temperatures from 30 degrees to -20 degrees. The colder the weather the more big deer we will kill so come prepared to stick it out, if you are just trying to survive the day you will not kill many bucks.

50% non-camo blaze orange jacket or vest and hat - IMPORTANT!

Backpack to carry clothing into stands to prevent sweating.

Weapon of at least .25 caliber for rifles with a good partition style bullet (we would prefer you use .270 to .300 caliber, these are tough, big bodied animals that can absorb and take a punch). For muzzle loaders we recommend .50 caliber (scopes and in-lines are legal) and 50# bows or 150# crossbows (legal). Remember you can't overkill these big Canadian Whitetail Deer.

Personal safety strap - IMPORTANT!

Small portable propane heater if you want one in your blind and hand warmers are a good idea you will need to get propane up here if you fly commercially..

If you have a climber or strap in stand bring it if you desire, sometimes we find a hot setup while scouting we may want to stick you in the next day before light rather than going back in again to set a stand to minimize human scent and activity.

If you smoke, bring along a nicotine substitute to get you through the day, no smoking allowed on stands - IMPORTANT!

Scent free bag for hunting clothing during transportation, meals, and lodging.

Scent eliminators are advised, (scent shields etc., but scent lock suits are excellent because our wind directions can shift several times a day or at mid-day) but do not use scents either sex or cover up without guides consent.

Hunting is done in heated blinds/stands overlooking natural baits and covering ground calling/howling natural wolf sounds and predator calls (moose calf, deer fawn, wolf pup, fox pup, ravens, etc...) in remote areas and deer leases.

The Wolf population is currently at an all-time high coinciding with a high deer population. Now is the time to take advantage of a peak. It is a challenging hunt with a high opportunity of success. Be prepared for long range shooting 100-400 yards.

## **CONDITIONS**

All funds in U.S. dollars.

\$600.00 USD deposit to hold booking, additional \$600.00 by September 1, and balance paid October 1 for deer hunts. January 1 for wolf hunt, no personal checks except for deposits.

Deposits will be refunded in full if for some reason we have to cancel hunt. If you must cancel deposits are nonrefundable but may be transferred during same year to another replacement or to the following year if we are able to rebook your slot in time availability. We have a limited number of hunts available each year because of a high repeat clientele, so please book your trip early. Some of our hunters have been with us each year since we started and over 60% of our bookings come from past guests or referrals.

## **Waterfowl**

### **WHERE WHEN AND WHAT YOU WILL BE HUNTING**

Ontario duck, goose, and grouse hunting on Eagle Lake and surrounding area offers some of the most overlooked hunting in Ontario. Our area offers a tremendous local population of unpressured ducks and geese early in the season with constant waves of migrations supplementing them from the north.

We are approximately 120 miles north of International Falls Minnesota, near the town of Vermilion Bay in Ontario Canada, with good roads right to our driveway.

Types of water fowl you will encounter are Greater Canada's Speckle Bellies, Snows/Blues, Greenhead Mallards, Black Ducks, Blue and Green Wing Teal, Woodies, Pintails and as the season progresses Ring-bills, Widgeons, Gadwall Buffleheads, Goldeneyes, Bluebills show up.

With liberal limits of 6 ducks /12 possession and 5 geese / 24 possession as well as addition limits for other geese species be sure and bring plenty of shells.

Our guides can outfit your every need with blinds, boats, decoys, dogs and are expert callers.

The many different types of areas we have to hunt from the main lake and it's many bays, backwaters, rivers, creeks and the backwaters and ponds with rice off of them, the main rivers and many backwater lakes off of them, as well as private leases with marshes and small lakes, beaver ponds, and grain fields gives us countless options, variety, and diversity to ensure an excellent and exciting hunt.

Goose season opens September 1st and duck season opens September 10th and runs through November.

The early season is a great time for geese, mallards, black ducks, teal and wood ducks over decoys on our private leases in the many beaver ponds, creeks and rice ponds off of them as well as the Eagle and Wabigoon Rivers and the many backwaters of the main lake.

We will take you to where the action is peaking. With the diversity in water and land we can hunt waterfowl all day by simply making a move between A.M. and P.M. flights to feeding or resting areas or jump shooting.

Or this is a great Waterfowling experience that can be combined with Waterfowling morning and evenings and grouse hunting or fishing at the prime time on world famous Eagle lake for trophy Musky, Walleye, Northern Pike, Bass, and Lake Trout. Even mix it up different ways through your trip, you could be doing something or combination of something different everyday.

## **UPLAND BIRD HUNTING**

Excellent populations (they are approaching a peak) of Ruffed Grouse, the beautiful Spruce Grouse and pockets of flocks of Sharp tails are available on the same leases as you go in and out for waterfowl shoots as well as hundreds and hundreds of miles of logging roads, hunting trails and clear cuts in the area for afternoon or all day hunts.

These are generally not the spooky birds (the locals refer to them as "chickens") as you are used to back home. No need to get into thick brush if you don't want to, a very relaxing hunt with plenty of close range shots along the edge of fields or clearings, logging roads and clear cuts.

Liberal limits of 5 per day and 15 in possession of one of the most exciting upland game birds as well as some the finest eating of all game birds combine for the makings for a great fall trip.



## **CAST AND BLAST COMBOS AND OPTIONS**

We can also combine am and pm waterfowl shoots with mid-day grouse hunts (many times you will encounter grouse going to and coming from duck/goose shoots also) and/or fishing both guided and unguided to make an exciting, diversified and exciting experience.

September and October are renowned for the trophy potential for world record muskies, big walleyes and northern pike and exciting opportunities for big smallmouth bass and lake trout.

What better way to spend a day starting out the morning and ending the day or going ½ day each with smoking barrels as greenheads and big Canadians come pouring into your spread and pursuing the trophy musky's, walleyes and other species Eagle Lake is known for during the prime trophy time of the season.

### **Border Crossing Information**

HEAD FOR THE BORDER with these border crossing regulations in mind!

Canada is so close and accessible; it's easy to forget it's a foreign country. And, being a foreign country, it has its share of border crossing regulations. Not to worry-crossing the border is a smooth procedure if you're able to follow directions. Scan this page before you head North, and contact Canada Customs, 1-800-461-9999, if you need more information.

### **ENTERING CANADA**

Citizens or legal permanent residents of the United States need a driver's license and birth certificate or form of citizenship (passport) to enter Canada, but ARE required to have passports in order to re-enter the United States if 18 years or older.

To assist officers in expediting the process, especially to re-enter the United States native-born citizens MUST have a passport and should carry a birth, baptismal, or voter's certificate. Proof of residence may also be required. Naturalized U.S. citizens should carry a naturalization certificate or other evidence of citizenship. Legal, permanent residents of the United States who are not U.S. citizens are advised to carry their Alien Reg. Receipt Card (U.S. Form 1-151 or Form 1-551). Persons under 18 years of age who

are not accompanied by an adult should bring a letter from a parent or guardian giving them permission to enter Canada.

### **ENTRY BY PRIVATE VEHICLE**

The entry of vehicles and vacation trailers into Canada for touring purposes is generally a quick and routine matter. Customs permits, if required, are issued at the time of entry. Rental vehicles or trailers are also admissible, however the vehicle registration forms should be carried together with a copy of the rental agency. Visitors entering Canada with vehicles not registered to themselves should carry a letter from the owner indicating authorized use of the vehicle. Note: Guidelines for entry by private aircraft or boats are also available from Tourism Canada.

### **PERSONAL BAGGAGE**

Visitors may bring personal baggage into Canada duty- and tax-free, provided all such items are declared to Canadian Customs on arrival and are not subject to restriction. Personal baggage may include such items as fishing tackle, boats, motors, snowmobiles, camping, golf, tennis and scuba diving gear, radios, television sets, cameras and other similar items to be used in Canada during the visit. Alcoholic beverages may be brought into Canada duty-free if visitors meet the minimum age requirement of the province or territory of entry (19 years in British Columbia, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, Northwest Territories, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Yukon and Saskatchewan; 18 years in Alberta, Manitoba and Quebec). The amount cannot exceed 1.1 litres (40 ounces) of liquors or wine, or 24 x 355 ml (12 ounce) cans or bottles of beer, ale or their equivalent. Additional quantities of alcoholic beverages, up to a maximum of nine litres (two gallons) may be imported into Canada, except Northwest Territories), upon payment of duty and taxes plus provincial fees at the port of entry. Persons 18 years of age in most jurisdictions, but 19 years in Newfoundland, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Ontario and British Columbia, may import 50 cigars, 200 cigarettes, and 2 lbs. of manufactured tobacco duty free. Federal duty and taxes apply to additional quantities. Subject to some restrictions, visitor may bring food with them for their own use, without Customs assessment, provided the quantity is consistent with the duration and nature of the visitor's stay. Gasoline and oil brought into Canada for consumption is dutiable. Reasonable quantities for tourist use such as gas and oil used to the normal capacity of the vehicle are granted free entry.

### **PLANTS AND ANIMALS**

All animals, plants, vegetables, fruit and meat (and any product of these) must be declared to Canadian Customs upon entry to the country and accompanied by import documentation when required and must pass inspection.

### **PETS**

Domestic dogs and cats may be brought into Canada provided each animal is accompanied by a licensed veterinarian certificate identifying the animal and certifying the dog or cat has been vaccinated against rabies during the preceding 36 month period. Up to two puppies or kittens under three months of age

and dogs for the visually impaired may enter with their owners without certification. Further information is available on other animals.

## **FIREARMS**

Handguns are not allowed entry into Canada. Firearms are divided into the following three categories: • Prohibited firearms are those that are capable of firing bullets in rapid succession during one pressure of the trigger and any that have been adapted from a rifle or shotgun so that its barrel measures less than 18 inches or is less than 26 inches overall in length. Restricted firearms include any designed or intended to be fired by one hand, any with a barrel less than 18.5 inches capable of firing center-fire ammunition in a semi-automatic manner and any that can be fired when reduced to a length less than 26 inches by folding or telescoping. Tourists cannot import restricted weapons. Long guns (regular rifles and shotguns) may be imported without permit by visitors over 16 years old. All visitors must declare all firearms to Canadian Customs. Most provinces and territories have regulations concerning the transportation of firearms. Visitors should check with the province.

## **FIREARMS IN NATIONAL PARKS**

Hunting is prohibited in Canada's national parks. Firearms cannot be carried in national parks unless unloaded and carried in a dismantled condition by separating the barrel and stock or are in a closed case, tied securely with no parts exposed.

## **AMMUNITION**

200 rounds of ammunition for hunting purposes can be imported duty free.

## **FISHING AND HUNTING**

Hunting is governed by federal, provincial, and territorial laws. Non-residents are required to obtain a hunting license from each province or territory in which they plan to hunt. When hunting migratory game birds, a federal migratory game bird hunting permit is also required. This permit is available at most Canadian post offices. In many of Canada's provincial parks, reserves, and adjacent areas, the entry of any type of weapon is forbidden. Further regulations can be obtained from each province. In the Northwest Territories, export permits are required to take out all unprocessed wildlife. Fishing is also governed by federal, provincial and territorial laws. Anglers must possess non-resident licenses for the provinces or territories in which they plan to fish. British Columbia also requires tidal waters sport fishing licenses. Special fishing permits are required to fish in all national parks. These permits can be obtained at any national park for a nominal fee and are valid in all national parks across Canada. No permit is required to import fishing tackle for personal use. Foreign fishing guides are not permitted to work in Canada without an employment authorization card.

## **RADAR DETECTION DEVICES**

The possession and use of radar detection services are illegal in Manitoba, Northwest Territories, Newfoundland, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, Quebec, and Yukon. It is suggested these units be

rendered inoperative and placed inside luggage when visitors are traveling through Canada. In Quebec and Ontario, it is illegal to possess these types of devices.

### **RETURNING TO THE STATES**

It is the responsibility of travelers to satisfy U.S. customs authorities of their rights to reenter the United States, through some form of identification. Reentry can be simplified if travelers keep a list of all purchases, have sales receipts and invoices handy, and pack purchases separately for inspection.

### **POSTAL SERVICE**

Canadian postal stamps may be used on all mail posted in Canada. Postage stamps can be purchased at post offices and automatic vending machines.
