











Hunt ID: CA-SK-WDeerBBear-Saskatoon-SCO-Walter

This is the best buy for a big Canadian whitetail on the market today with a prime hunting area that encompasses 150 square miles. My multiple trips to Canadian provinces have provided me with many details and insight that separated each province. My personal favorite is Saskatchewan. Some of those reasons are that the deer can be baited with alfalfa and oats. The reason this is so important is that non-residents are not allowed to hunt the lush farm land of the southern half of the province. In the northern areas most of what you will see is heavy timber, minimal feed and minimal deer per acre. The baiting is a very good way to concentrate the deer. One is he is as far south as any non-resident can hunt, close to the farm land, and at the first shot the farm land deer make a mass stampede into his timber.

This outfitter has many things going for him that makes him the best buy for the money in a Canadian whitetail hunt. His south property boarder is on the state set line. Better yet when the residents come out to hunt the agricultural ground the deer head for the timber, the first timber they make contact with his. Also there was one thing in additions to this but it is in the cost area. His hunt price is some of the lowest; he has free pickup from the airport, no rental car needed.

You will have 5 ¾ days to hunt from the wooden blinds are well built with sliding windows, to conserve heat. You have not only a heater in your blind, but also a body bag cocoon (much like a large sleeping bag), to make you even warmer. Remember the colder the weather the better the hunting, if it is cold you want to be in the blind. Possibly this would be to warm? Not a chance, these are all available at no charge, Take them to the blind then decide if you want to use them or not.

This outfitter has 15 years of whitetail and bears outfitting experience, is a member of the Saskatchewan Outfitters Association. He is a lifetime Saskatchewan resident and has hunted in this province since his youth. His personal best whitetail deer scored 187 6/8 B&C. Their goal to ensure your hunting experience is comfortable and successful.

With an average of 5 hunters in camp per week, Walter and his two experienced guides are able to focus on quality of the hunt, not quantity of hunters. The guides, Wayne and Ross, have been with Stewart Creek Outfitters for several years and are friendly, skilled, knowledgeable and familiar with the area.

All equipment utilized for hunting is up-to-date and well maintained. A variety of different ATV's (four wheelers, side-by-sides, and Argos) are available to use depending on the condition and terrain. Hunters are provided with a radio for communicating with their guide during the hunt.

Your Hunting Experience

Your hunt begins in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. We provide pickup at the airport and then travel 2.5 hours north to the private camp situated in the middle of the hunting area. The hunting area is located in the Northern Boreal forest and is directly bordered by alfalfa fields in the farmland to the south. Because of the higher availability of feed for the deer in the area there is a much higher concentration of deer in the area, increasing your odds of taking home a wall hanger.

It is not unusual to see 15 bucks in a day in your stand. You will have a 99% chance of seeing a 140 class buck or larger and the 187 came from this outfitters property.

Upon arrival, you will settle into one of three fully modern cabins before heading over to the main lodge. At the main lodge it is time to meet the staff and fellow hunters, sight-in your weapon, and plan for the upcoming hunt over a hearty meal.

The next day your active bait and stand await. Experienced guides will deliver you via truck and ATV. All baits have been well established for multiple years and are replenished regularly throughout the season. You climb into your fully enclosed stand and watch your surroundings come into focus as the sun rises. It is only a matter of time before your trophy reveals himself. This is a chance of lifetime to harvest a world class, record breaking animal.

The service does not end after the hunt. Once your trophy is down, our guides will ensure that it is properly dressed and packaged to be transported to the taxidermist of your choice. Enjoy the remainder of your time resting and relaxing in the beautiful northern setting.

Accommodations

The lodge at White Gull Camp is set in a quiet and peaceful area deep into the forest. The camp is surrounded by White Gull Creek. The lodge is fully modern with a very rustic appeal. There is a main lodge where you will enjoy home cooked meals and the company of others. If you choose you may retire to a separate cabin at any time you like. The separate cabins will accommodate four hunters each with their own private room and a common sitting area with satellite television.

Upon arrival, you will settle into one of three fully modern cabins before heading over to the main lodge. At the main lodge it is time to meet the staff and fellow hunters, sight-in your weapon, and plan for the upcoming hunt over a hearty meal.

The main lodge is a place to gather and share stories. Two delicious, home cooked meals are served in the main lodge daily. A bagged lunch is provided while you are hunting.

The Stewart Creek Outfitters lodge at White Gull Camp is situated in the horseshoe of a creek in the peaceful Boreal forest, in northern Saskatchewan.

Three separate, spacious cabins accommodate four hunters, each with their own private room. Each cabin also has a kitchenette and common sitting area with satellite television.

Whitetail Deer Hunting

The whitetail deer habitat available for hunting has an extensive area of approximately 150 square miles. This area has a huge population of whitetail deer and is bordered by alfalfa farmland for ten miles on the southern edge. This is the optimum habitat for producing a trophy class Saskatchewan whitetail buck.

We offer variety of stand setups, including archery, rifle, ground blinds, and elevated stands.

These setups are available in a variety of different terrains - clearings, ridges, and along the farmland fringe only hundreds of yards away from bordering alfalfa fields. All stands are fully enclosed and capable of being heated, if you so choose.

Bear Hunting

Areas for hunting bear are scouted regularly by Stewart Creek Outfitter guides, and have proven time and time again to be excellent for hunting.

A high ratio of baits to hunters ensures a busy stand and provides plenty of action! It is not uncommon to see multiple bears in one evening. Each year we harvest a good number of large and color phase bears. The challenge is to hold out for the trophy of your choice.

We offer early spring hunts out of the White Gull Camp approximately 40 km north of Smeaton Saskatchewan. This area offers excellent bear hunts. The area is scouted regularly for signs of bear activity and offers excellent chances for success. A high ratio of baits to hunters ensures a busy stand and provides plenty of action! It is not uncommon to see multiple bears in one evening. The challenge is to hold out for the trophy of your choice. Each year we harvest a good number of large and color phase bears.

Spring fishing is also available at both bear hunting locations. Bring your fishing gear and enjoy the opportunity to catch Northern Pike and Lake Trout. Fishing can be very good in the early spring.

When you're not hunting bear, spring time fishing in Saskatchewan is excellent! There is great opportunity to fish nearby (at no extra cost!). Try for brook trout right out the back door of your cabin or for feisty northern pike in a nearby lake. Remember to bring your rod and tackle. Boats and motors are provided.
