







Hunt ID: CA-SK-WDeerBearElkBuffaloWaterfowl-All-ONHUDS-OFRO-EAND

This Saskatchewan hunting for trophy Elk, Whitetail Deer, waterfowl and upland Duck, Goose, Black Bear, Chocolate Brown and Blonde Bear hunts in Upper Eastern Saskatchewan, Western Canada with local guides and lodging. The Canadian hunt market has always had hunts of this quality of over \$5000. This one with lodging and meals is \$1500 below that which is what makes it a deal. Keep in mind in Canada all hunts include lodging different from the US with the hunt only or guided hunt only. I have tried doing it by using town lodging and by the time you add outside meals and lodging I have found that because the hunt areas are so remote from most towns the early morning drive with unknown weather conditions requires you to rent a 4x4 vehicle and the snow maintenance is not like the US nor starting vehicles in - degree weather take away reliability and leaves you a very good chance you will miss or at least be late getting into the stand at least one day so staying with the outfitter that is all his problem and he has "plan B's" to handle any situation. A heater in the blind takes the chill of and you are ready to hunt.

If you have ever hunted Canada before after big whitetails you will see that the regulations are different for each province.

No baiting in Alberta can make it difficult when just a short distance away is Saskatchewan where baiting is legal but aliens (anyone that is not a Canadian resident) must not hunt in the lower farm area but only north of the farming area. You will be hunting in the northern woods and tall timber where the deer density is low but you have thousands of acres of Queensland (National Forest) available. You will sit in a stand with a mixture of alfalfa and covered with oats about 100 yards from you tent or plywood ground blind. Always bring a heater the November gun season temperatures are

seldom above 20F. For this cold experience you can easily expect to pay over \$5000 for this chilling adventure, but success is an unbelievable 95%.

The light has come on and there aren't many bright days in the cold Canadian plains winter but here is one that is the light at the end of the tunnel and noticeable for those that have faired the harsh winter. In north east Saskatchewan next to the Manitoba boarder is a outfitter that know what make deer and what makes big deer. It is a combination of woods for thermo-shelter. Add to that farm country to hunt, about 20,000 acres of wheat, pasture and more. An outfitter that grows his own wheat is not stingy with the bait and that is what not only draws deer but brings in the does that stay on the feed, which brings in the bucks to breed the does because the does are never anywhere else.

No wide open exposed tree hang on blinds. Most are ground blinds of one sort or another that have a shooting lane cut between them and the bait. They also have heaters for the southern hunters. If you want to go home with a heavy 170 class whitetail under your arm this is the place to go.

This outfitter has a family owned business that pays attention to every detail and is known for their personal service. Their guides are knowledgeable, and focused on your success. They are keenly interested in your success, not only in the quality of your trophy, but in the quality of your hunt.

They have built as repeat clientele that takes about 70% of their hunts each year. You will be staying is a 3,000 sq. foot modern lodge, including a trophy room, fireplace, large dining area and two single beds per bedroom. The meals are home-cooked and delicious.
