We prefer camp size 2-4 hunters/camp. Larger groups are welcome. Your hunt can also be extended depending on the season.*

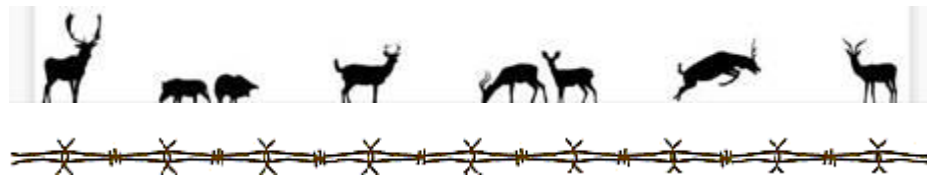

Muzzleloading September 14-22,
1st Rifle Limited Draw Elk ONLY Oct. 12- 16,
2nd Rifle Over the Counter Elk* Draw for Mule Deer Oct. 19-27,
3rd Rifle Over the Counter Elk Draw Mule Deer*November 2-10,
4th Rifle Limited Licenses (Draw) Draw Elk and/or Mule Deer November 13-17, *Bull License Only. (Draw for Cow Elk)

*Youth hunters subject to reduces rates.

**Application Deadline 3/28 for Big Game Licenses. I recommend that you put in for the draws weather you have points or not.



Archery Season Go in on Sunday and come out on a Saturday (Break between 2 groups)
5 day hunt with 1 day (Saturday) in and 1 day (Sunday) out (season start 8/26)
Season Dates are as follows:

Sunday	Saturday
1 st week 08/26-09/02	Archery*
2 st Week 09/03-09/09	Archery
3 nd week 09/10-09/16	Muzzleloader/Archery
4 th week 09/17-09/24	Archery*

Note: Because season dates and the days of the week don't align perfectly so the First week has a 1 day earlier and the last week has 1 extra day on the end.

- 1st Season 10/14--18
- 2nd Season 10/21-29
- 3rd Season 11/04-12
- 4th Season 11/15-19
