This outfitter has such a high customer satisfaction level that he seldom needs new bookings. Although there is room for turkey and pheasant hunts still in 2010. They are located by Cuba Kansas a popular area for big buck, large flocks of turkeys and miles and miles of premium pheasant habitat.

These guys have had a lot of hunting success over the years and taken some monster bucks, now they would like to share this opportunity with everyone.

They would offer some of the best whitetail hunting available in the Midwest and accept only a limited clientele.

It is their personal goal to see that all their hunters go home satisfied, and assure the hunter that they gave 100% of their efforts to make the hunt a true success.

If you're looking for a quality deer hunt in true Kansas style, this is the place. With access to prime deer habitat encompassing over 5000 acres within a 20 mile radius from the lodge big bucks have a chance to grow bigger. This allows our hunters to experience a truly solitary hunt with very little to no pressure from other hunters.

The land consists of creek bottoms with heavy wooded draws surrounded by corn, milo, soybean, sunflower and CRP fields. We have over 60 stands in place and ready to hunt when you arrive. It is very hard to find a straight tree in Kansas, therefore, a majority of

the stands are ladder stands, but we also hunt out of hang on stands. We recommend all hunters wear their safety harnesses at all times while in the tree.

This is a semi-guided deer hunt. The guides will take you to and from your hunting area and stand locations in the mornings and evenings. Hunters are more than welcome to hunt all day or whatever hours they prefer. During your hunt, if you notice a specific area that looks promising, just let us know and we'll formulate a game plan together to either scout it or hang a stand.

This outfitter takes great pride in quality deer management. Our goal is to harvest mature deer. In order to ensure a quality hunt for you and others that follow we have implemented a 130" gross minimum score on any deer shot. A fine will be issued for any buck scoring under 130" gross.

Kansas Archery Deer Hunting: The Archery season starts on the first day of October and runs through the end of December. Archery Hunts are located in Unit #8. All hunts are 5 day / 6 night hunts, lodging included.

Kansas Rifle Deer Hunting: The Rifle season starts the Wednesday after Thanksgiving and runs to the second Sunday in December. Rifle hunts are located in Unit 8. All hunts are 5 day / 6 night hunts, lodging included.

Kansas Deer Permits: Whether rifle or bow, are obtained through a lottery drawing by the State of Kansas. A license for unit 8 or any area directly attached to unit 8 will qualify.

DEGREE OF PHYSCIAL EXERTION: Is usually minimal in tree stand hunting, Contact outfitter for game retrieval assistance.

All land that is hunted is private land broken down into agriculture fields, CRP and woodlots.

The lodge is located about 15 miles south of the Nebraska boarder, straight north of Salina Kansas.

The nearest town is Cuba or Belleview.

Hunters flying in can land in Kansas City or in Omaha and rent a car to get to the lodge.

Application Deadline: The application deadline for the lottery is May 1st thru May 31st. When you book the outfitters will notify you at the time of application, the applicant is responsible for applying. They will provide any assistance necessary in filling them out.

Kansas Hunter Education: Required if you were born after July 1, 1957. You must carry your card with you. If you are a non-resident and have a Hunter Safety Card from your home state you will need to bring it to get a Kansas license and you will need to carry it while hunting in Kansas. If hunting in Kansas, you must have a hunting license plus your permit. The hunting license is good for the calendar year, and entitles you to hunt small game and game birds also

The Accommodations

The lodge was built over 100 years ago. It is one of the oldest operating farmyards in the state of Kansas, and consists of an older/updated farm house. The lodge is located in the heart of one of our best pieces of hunting property. It is not uncommon to see trophy whitetails running through the yard or hearing a trophy gobbler yards away in the creek bottom.

Our lodge will be booked with deer hunters that end of October thru the 1st week of November. Any bookings on bird hunters would have to stay in a motel in Belleville (10 minutes) and meet us at the lodge each morning. Hunters are more than welcome to bring their own dogs as well.

Sleeping accommodations

Lodge has 3 bedrooms, and can sleep up to 8 guests at a time.

Entertainment

Flat screen TV, Dish Network Satellite TV and Fire pit/Picnic Tables outside for evening enjoyment.

Amenities

Shower, Washer/Dryer, Stove, Microwave, Grill and all cooking utensils Food/Beverages

Hunts include lodging, but hunters are to bring their own food and beverages of choice.

Kansas Turkey Hunting

We have thousands of acres of private land that has an abundance of turkey. We primarily have Rio-Grande species with some Merriam/Rio Hybrid turkeys. Our properties are located in Unit #2, and allow hunters to take 2 birds each. In past years we have experienced great success rates with 90% of the hunters killing one mature bird and 80% killing two mature birds. We offer a semi-guided 3 day / 4 night hunt, lodging included.

Semi Guided Hunts: The outfitters will assist hunters in all ways, they will show the hunter the land, provide maps of their properties and show them where the birds are roosting and eating prior to the start of the hunt. A typical hunt consists of hunting the roost in the morning. Then mid morning thru the afternoon the turkeys are out feeding/breeding which require spot/stock hunting. Then in the evenings it is best to set up and wait for the turkeys to come back to roost.

Season: Our turkey season starts the first week of April, with a 10 day Archery season. After those 10 days our shotgun season starts which allows hunters to hunt with either shotgun or bow, with the season ending the last day of May.

Permits: All turkey permits are over-the-counter and can be purchased from the Kansas Department of Wildlife & Parks website, or purchased upon your arrival from a local vendor.
