This is by far the most fun you can have with your clothes and I will even put it in the Guinness book of World Records.

(Note weight restrictions: The combined weight of shooters plus the guns and ammo we provide on the aircraft cannot exceed 500 pounds. We use the average of 25 pounds for the ammunition and the AR-15 Semi-automatic 223. This leaves the shooters to total less than 475 pounds. If they are over 475 pounds they must each go individually which is \$ 1500. Additionally there is a seat limit of 300 pounds. Safety is of up most importance in your hunt as far as aircraft and of the hunting/rifles.)

We aren't millionaires and we work hard to put food on the family table and a roof over their head. There is a time when you say I want to something for me, I have earned it and I deserve it!

Hunt Pricing flying on specific days weather permitting.

In the past that might be true but you were still looking at a \$2000 bill to shoot hogs and coyotes from the air. I asked my wife if I could go and spend that much money on a 1 hour helicopter flight and she

didn't agree and then mumbled something about her mother I believe, it wasn't a positive conversation so I let it go at that.

Then I worked with one Helicopter pilot and outfitter, with a high hit success (I shot 6 hogs and a coyote, and saw more of both, that are alive today because of my shooting skills, or lack of them when I first started the flight. I didn't know about "reverse lead." A catchy term for shoot behind the hog if you are flying in the same direction as the hog you shoot behind their butt and you will catch them in mud body. I kept shooting in front of them and missing. We were flying faster than the hog was running (Hogs run at speed up to 11 mph). We had probably slowed down to about 50 or 60 mph.

I had the outfitters special AR-15 in 223, but could have used his AK semi-automatic 12 gauge shotgun slinging out 12 gauge Double OO buck shot loads of 12 pellets each time you pull the trigger. The AR has an excellent red dot and circle that made the AR very accurate and since I went through two 30 round .223 clips in an hour there was plenty of shooting available, and needless to say there is plenty of hogs and coyotes still out there. The AR's and the AK are both quality firearms with no jams, and they even provide you with all the ammo you can shoot.

I will agree that 2 hours are better than one as in any hunting situation. So your odds of getting into a whole lot of hogs doubles if you go 2 hours instead of 1 hour, but affordability is number 1 in this case.

I guess the conversation would be I have 4 times the opportunity if I went 4 hours also. Select what you can afford and enjoy shooting the hogs you encounter.

We book in groups of 4 shooters so that when the helicopter is pulled out of the hanger it clocks 2 full hours of flying. That is a requirement to get this discounted pricing. If you have a friend or hunting buddy that wants to shoot please free to invite him too at \$795 for an hour in the air, shooting hogs I can guarantee he will never have an opportunity like this a gin, It is a one in a lifetime adventure that you can tell your hunting buddies and they will want to hear about the whole thing unless they didn't get to go.

This is a pilot program for 3 months then we will look at it and if we aren't breaking even on the helicopter time the program will be sunset. So at this point I can only book for a total of 3 months, so be certain to get in before the program may end.

Let's get back to the money situation that I worked out with the outfitter for the clients that I send him from me personally.

It is only \$ 795 per person when you go up with another shooter. Bring a buddy to be your partner and with both of you on the left side of the copter shooting you can both see what each one is shooting for giving your buddy a bad time later. If you don't have a buddy you would be going alone at \$ 1495. There is more shooting than 1 man can handle, but you can try it if you wish. In total it is required that we consume 2 hours of flying time to get this pricing. If you don't have a 4 hunter group one can take two hour while the others take only 1 hour. Or if made far enough in advance we may be able to pair you up with another group.

Since you are both on the left side of the aircraft the pilot only needs to do is position the aircraft so that the hogs or coyotes are on the left side of the aircraft at a 45 degree angle and listen to the rattle fire of the AR rifle fire.

One unique point is that at the beginning in a new area full of hogs you seldom see a coyote. As you leave some of the hogs on the ground it attracts the coyotes is for dinner. Soon you have shot the hogs, and the coyote from and areas and the farmers and ranchers are pleasantly satisfied with the outcome, no long ditches in their pastures and fields from hogs rooting to eat plant roots. Then when the coyotes are gone the bird and small animal life returns and the calf, lamb and fawn survival rate quickly increases.

Just to change the subject for a short time my wife and I road in a tourist helicopter over Disney world a few years ago. It was \$ 400 for 2 of us for 15 short minutes which would be \$ 1600 for an hour for both of us. The price on this Texas Hog Chopper hunt is less than half the price of the Disney flight, plus you get to shoot out of the helicopter and your AR or shotgun is provided along with all of the ammo that you can burn.

Because this definitely eradicates the hog population since it is so efficient they are constantly securing more land, and moving the helio-pad closer to the best hunting areas. One thing that was high on my mind since I have flown single engine airplanes and even helicopters was safety.

You will receive a safety briefing before your flight. When you load up you will be briefed and shown. You are buckled into the aircraft so you can't fall out. Even your weapon of choice is clipped into the aircraft. The large banana clips of ammo is not attach to the aircraft so I recommend getting all of the way inside the aircraft when you change clips. Drop the empty clip on the floor and it won't fly out.

The trip can be videotaped from your view to watch later. You will see the hogs and the shots fired real tine with a camera attached to your front visor if you wish for a small fee.

Both the Pilot and the outfitter have extensive training and background in flying and helicopter flying. They are very serious about safety and confirm that you are also.

**Where will the FAA allow you to have a loaded Firearm in an aircraft?**

**Where will the FAA allow you to shoot from an aircraft?**

Helicopter Preventive Maintenance is extremely high in price. Parts are discarded and replaced by new ones when they look perfectly fine. In all aircraft you are required to do this preventive maintenance procedure based on the number of hours the air craft has been in the air no matter if it looks worn out or looks brand new. There is no pulling over by the side of the road if a part fails like there is with a car. You change it because you have a schedule to change out each part, "before" is scheduled to break. A good idea, but costly, though scheduled maintenance is never as costly as the alternate, wait until it is deemed enough hours and having it break.

You are welcome to take all of the hogs you wish.

Ultimately outfitters goal is to provide an invaluable service to landowners saving them from as much damage and crop loss each year as possible while providing a hunting experience tailored for each hunter or group of hunters that is sure to be an experience of a lifetime!

It is not the big importance of the game animal to your trophy collection as it is in your hunting experience in your memories. It will be with you the rest of your life. Guaranteed.
